COMMITTEE REPORTS

<u>Finance</u> - Mr. Henry Youmans, Town Administrator as of November we have exhausted 42% of our budget for the Municipal year 2020. We have received reimbursement from Barnwell County for one of our officers (E. Mcrae)

<u>Police Departments</u> – Chief Sullivan stated the Police Department has increased patrol due to the Christmas Holidays. They will also be increasing vehicle safety checkpoints throughout the town. They will be putting more attention to the business, especially the ones that are open late. Chief Sullivan is asking the citizens to please be aware of their surroundings. Please be sure to secure their property. The Council will receive a copy of their performance for the year.

Council Lady Jackson is asking about the card that was once put in the doors of the business as they were checked. Also, requesting for the officers to walk through the Local stores, making their presence known.

Council Lady Lewis also asked the Chief to let the citizens know about the advisory board that was created by the Police Department, Sheriff Department and some of the citizens. Also, requesting to ride through the parking lots of the stores due to citizens parking illegally.

<u>Personnel/Mechanics</u> – Mr. Henry Youmans, Town Administrator stated that we have a potential hire as soon as his office receives all of the necessary paperwork.

<u>Water and Sewer Department</u> - Alan Stanley, Water & Sewer Superintendent, stated that the department has almost completed reading of the meters. The department will be coming up with a list of meters that have a defect, so that we will know how many to order. Aware of all the leaks throughout the Town, trying to complete them as soon as they can.

<u>Sanitation</u> – Lonzado Badger, stated that they are removing trees and debris from throughout the Town. The Town's Flatbed Truck is out being repaired.

Council Lady Lewis is requesting a schedule from the streets and sanitation department.

<u>Community Development</u> – Mr. Henry Youmans, let the citizens know that there will be a Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony on Saturday, December 12 @ 4:30pm at the Town of Allendale Farmers Market. We have some Covid-19 testing sites going on throughout the Town. Council Lady Lewis let the citizens know that they will also be giving away bicycles at the event.

Mayor Cohen also let the council members know that Mrs. Shirley Cave is asking if any of the Council Members are interested in giving a short Christmas video to our citizens.
